PROCEDURE FOR ADOPTION AND AMENDMENT OF PERFORMANCE STANDARDS FOR RADIO AND NAVIGATIONAL EQUIPMENT

THE ASSEMBLY,

RECALLING Article 15(j) of the Convention on the International Maritime Organization concerning the functions of the Assembly in relation to regulations and guidelines concerning maritime safety,

RECALLING ALSO that regulation IV/14 and regulation V/12(r) of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS), 1974, as amended, requires all equipment fitted, in compliance with chapter IV and regulation V/12 thereof, to conform to appropriate performance standards not inferior to those adopted by the Organization,

RECALLING FURTHER that it adopted performance standards for radio and navigational equipment at its seventh, eighth, eleventh, twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth, seventeenth, eighteenth and nineteenth sessions,

NOTING that many of these performance standards are under review by the Maritime Safety Committee and amendments thereto are under preparation,

RESOLVES that the function of adopting performance standards for radio and navigational equipment, as well as amendments thereto, shall be performed by the Maritime Safety Committee on behalf of the Organization.
