

RESOLUTION A.401(X)

ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AD HOC WORKING GROUP

THE ASSEMBLY,

NOTING Resolution A.400(X) by which it adopted amendments to the IMCO Convention,

HAVING CONSIDERED a number of proposals for further amendments to the Convention, in particular proposals from the Governments of France, Italy and Nigeria,

BEING UNABLE to consider and take decisions on these proposals in accordance with the requirements of Article 52 of the Convention,

CONSIDERING that these proposals require to be fully examined prior to their being considered for possible adoption,

DECIDES to convene early in 1979 an Ad Hoc Working Group open to all Member Governments with the following terms of reference:

“To study and submit to the eleventh regular session of the Assembly proposals for amending the IMCO Convention, having regard to the submissions presented to the tenth session of the Assembly by the Governments of France, Italy and Nigeria, and other proposals which may be submitted by Member Governments.”,

REQUESTS the Secretary-General to assemble and circulate forthwith to all Member Governments the proposals for amendment submitted to the tenth session of the Assembly, any proposals which may be received from Member Governments as well as relevant information on any such proposals,

FURTHER REQUESTS the Secretary-General to submit to Member Governments the Report of the Ad Hoc Working Group and, in accordance with Article 52 of the IMCO Convention, any texts of amendments recommended by the Working Group for consideration at the eleventh regular session of the Assembly,

AUTHORIZES the Secretary-General to make the necessary financial and other arrangements for the convening of the Ad Hoc Working Group.
