

RESOLUTION A.192(VI)

REVISION OF THE REGULATIONS FOR  
PREVENTING COLLISIONS AT SEA, 1960

The Assembly,

*Taking note* of Article 16 of the Convention on the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization concerning the functions of the Assembly,

*Noting further* Article 29 of the Convention on the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization concerning the duties of the Maritime Safety Committee,

*Having considered* the Reports of the Maritime Safety Committee, and having approved the said Reports by Resolution A.190(VI),

*Decides*

- (a) to endorse the Committee's view that an international conference for revision of the Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1960, should be held in 1972;
- (b) to request the Committee to pursue the study of the matter and to advance as far as possible the preparatory work for the said conference;
- (c) to request the Secretary-General to make, in due course, administrative and financial proposals, as necessary, for holding such a conference in 1972 in the light of the progress of the Committee's work,

*Requests* the Committee to inform, through the Council, the next Assembly of the progress made in this matter.

RESOLUTION A.193(VI)

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CONTAINER TRAFFIC

The Assembly,

*Noting* Article 16 of the Convention on the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization concerning the functions of the Assembly,

*Having considered* the Reports of the Maritime Safety Committee and, in particular, the Committee's view that a number of problems under study by the Organization should, sooner or later, be dealt with by international conferences,

*Noting further* the decision of the Council to provide for an international conference of fourteen days' duration in 1971, the subject to be decided according to the progress achieved in the fields concerned,
