Establishment of working relations with the International Atomic Energy Agency and other specialized agencies of the United Nations, including more particularly the International Civil Aviation Organization, the International Telecommunication Union, the World Meteorological Organization, the World Health Organization, the Food and Agriculture Organization, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization and the Universal Postal Union.

Noting in addition Article III of the Financial Regulations,

Having considered the Report of the Council, Resolves that

1. For the financial period 1962 to 1963 appropriations are voted for the following purposes:

- 2. The appropriations voted in paragraph 1 above shall be financed by contributions from Member States after adjustment as provided in the Financial Regulations; for this purpose miscellaneous income is estimated at \$13,200.
- 3. Contributions from Member States shall be paid in accordance with the scale of assessments approved for the second financial period 1962 to 1963.
- 4. Notwithstanding the relevant provisions of Article IV of the Financial Regulations, the Secretary-General is authorized for the second financial period and with the prior concurrence of the Council, to transfer credits between sections of the budget for a calendar year and to carry forward uncommitted balances of appropriations from one calendar year to the ensuing calendar year.
- 5. The estimate for each of the calendar years 1962 and 1963 covered by the financial period are indicated under relevant headings, as shown in Annex I to this resolution. The manning table for the second financial period is shown in Annex II to this resolution,

Invites the Council to comply with the abovementioned provisions,

Instructs the Secretary-General to ensure their application.
